

**NCAA Health and Safety Speakers Grant
Speaker's Application**

GUIDELINES:

In order to be listed on the NCAA Speakers Grant List, an applicant must provide:

1. Documentation of his or her **credentials**. This can be a curriculum vitae or resume, information identifying training/degrees or a full account of life experiences which may provide expertise in an area.
2. **Topic and description of the program** that will be presented to student-athletes. The program must deal with the health/wellness topics defined by the committee governing these funds. These topics include alcohol, tobacco and other drug abuse prevention/addictions (including gambling); nutrition; stress management (mental health); sexual health issues (including sexual assault prevention and GLBT issues); and hazing.
3. **Name, contact information and a letter of reference** from an individual on campus who has heard the speaker's presentation within the last two years, and is willing to be posted on the NCAA Web site as a reference.

Institutions may apply for one \$500 grant per semester (application deadline September 1 for fall programs, January 15 for spring programs) per academic year (August 1 through July 31). Speakers grant funds cannot be used for travel, lodging or other non-fee expenses. Speaker fees are determined by the speaker and the institution. [**Note:** Although a speaker is listed, each application from an institution must still be approved for content and target audience.]
